Sealed bids will be received by the **City of Miami, Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 1st Floor, 3500 Pan American Drive, Miami, Florida 33133-5504** for:

DINNER KEY MOORING FACILITY – B33511

Bids Due: MONDAY - JANUARY 12, 2009 AT 2:00 P.M.

Scope of Work: The Work consists of furnishing all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to achieve the following:

Construction of the Dinner Key Mooring Fields Phase One Project, Mooring Areas Three and Four along with the demarcation of Area Five using Coast Guard approved hazardous area buoys. All mooring field construction on City-owned submerged lands and the information buoys installed in either City-owned submerged or sovereign submerged lands. Area Three is to be comprised of 200 moorings and 23 regulatory buoys with solar powered lights. Area Four is to be comprised of 25 moorings and 9 regulatory buoys with solar powered lights. Area Five is to be demarked with 31 information buoys with solar powered lights. The Contractor shall be responsible for determining the type and length of embedment anchor required for each mooring.

CIP has scheduled a non-mandatory pre-bid conference and site visit which will be held at the following date, time and location:

Minimum Requirements: Prospective Bidder shall hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida (and/or Subcontractors) and must have a minimum of five (5) years experience in Marine Construction including the construction of similar projects including five (5) separate projects of similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references within the past five (5) years. The Bidder must self-perform at least twenty percent (20%) of the physical construction work.
