

Background

Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received four (4) bids on May 29, 2009 in response to the solicitation for the creation of the Dinner Key Marina Maintenance Dredging project.


Bidders were required to hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida or a General Engineering license from Miami-Dade County and possess a minimum of five (5) years experience in mechanical dredging and sediment dewatering in projects of a similar size, scope and complexity, supported by references for three (3) projects within the past seven (7) years. One of these projects must have been performed within the State of Florida. Experience must also include maintenance dredging within the influences of tidal currents with varying sediments ranging from silt, organics, from fine to coarse grain sand. The Bidder must be capable of self-performing at least thirty-five percent (35%) of the physical construction work.

Findings

CIP has completed its review of the low bidder, American Earth Movers, Inc., and has determined that the company is also the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Contract Execution

On December 11, 2008 the City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to execute a Contract for this project in accordance with Attachment A of Ordinance 08-01316, "Economic Stimulus Awards and Agreements." Upon approval, we will commence the process required for award of a contract.
