The following changes, additions, clarifications, and/or deletions amend the above-captioned Bid/Contract documents, and shall become an integral part of the bid responses and the subsequent contract. Please note the contents herein and affix same to the documents you have on hand.

All are available as attachments on the CIP website and are part of this Addendum.

Request for Information-Pre-Bid Meeting

The following information is in response to questions from the non-mandatory Pre-Bid meeting and Site-Visit held on May 11, 2009 at 11:00 a.m.

Q1. Will the awarded contractor be required to pull permits on this project?

A2. It is imperative that all bidders review all permit requirements thoroughly. The Dinner Key Marina Mitigation project has the following permits in place and approved:

- 1) United States Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE);
- 2) Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP);
- 3) Miami-Dade County's Department of Environmental Resources Management (DERM);

Please note: Please review permit requirements accordingly to ensure compliance.

The awarded contractor will have to pull a City of Miami Public Works permit. The fees for the City of Miami Public Works permit will be waived.

Q2. Will there be a designated staging area for the rock?

A2. Yes. There will be a staging area provided to the contractor. The size of equipment used by awarded contractors will factor in deciding the exact location of the staging area. The Dinner Key Marina Site is the site for loading. The contractor shall submit the location of the loading area during the pre-Construction Meeting to be approved by The City of Miami Construction Manager and the Engineer of Record.

Q3. Will the project be monitored by DERM?

A3. Yes, as will ACOE, and FDEP.

Q4. What type of City of Miami permit will be required?

A4. The contractor will be required to secure a Public Work's waterfront permit.

Q5. Will there be survey criteria?

A5. Yes.

Q6. On the cross-sections, the edge of grass is listed at 17ft. out from the riprap; Is that 17ft out the beginning or the ending of the seagrass?

A6. It is the beginning of the sea grass that extends offshore. Between this line and the shore, there is no seagrass.

Q7. Is this a lump sum bid?

A7. Yes. All bids must be submitted as a lump sum bids. However, payment will be made based on actual work performed.

Q8. Will the contractor be required to conduct a post dredge survey?

A8. Yes.

Q9. Are there special limitations to the methods used in the dredging process?

A9. Yes. Please refer to the DEP permits in the bid documents.

Q10. Will the contractor be responsible for future damage or cavitations to seawall after the dredging project is complete?

A10. Insurance must be in place up to 3 years after completion of the project. Please review the insurance requirements stated in the bid documents.

Q11. Will the contractor responsible for endangered species, environmental and turbidity monitoring?

A11. Yes.

Additional RFI's:

Q12. Where can I obtain a bidder's list?

A12. Attached you will find a pre-bid conference sign in sheet.

Q13. Please clarify Section 3, Supplemental Terms and Conditions, paragraph #3, Progress Payments. There is not any indication whether or not the truck weight ticket is the valid method; or as a calculated volume and weight as installed.

A13. It depends on the equipment used in the process.

If the contractor uses a barge, then payments will be calculated according the barge weight. If the contractor uses a truck, then payments will be calculated according to the truck ticket.

Q14. What is the estimated budget for the project?

A14. \$332,000.00
