

Background

Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received three (3) bids on January 12, 2009 in response to the solicitation for the creation of the Dinner Key Mooring Field.

The work specified for this project includes the creation of a Dinner Key Mooring Field comprised of 225 moorings, 32 regulatory buoys and 31 informational buoys.


Bidders were required to hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida and possess a minimum of five (5) years experience in Marine Construction including the construction of similar projects. The Bidder must be capable of self-performing at least twenty percent (20%) of the physical construction work.

Findings

CIP has completed its review of the low bidder, American Underwater Contractors, Inc. and has determined that the company is also the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. American Underwater Contractors, Inc.'s price is below the estimated cost of construction and is, therefore, deemed by CIP as a fair and reasonable bid.

Contract Execution

On December 11, 2008 the City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to execute a Contract for this project in accordance with Attachment A of Ordinance 08-01316, "Economic Stimulus Awards and Agreements." Upon approval, we will commence the process required for award of a contract.
