



Background

The Department of Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received fourteen (14) bids on February 13, 2009, in response to the solicitation for the construction of the, which are reflected on the attached Bid Submittals List.

The scope of work for the project is as follows:

The Work specified in this Bid consists of furnishing all labor, machinery, tools, means of transportation, supplies, equipment, materials, and services, and incidentals necessary to perform the following Work at a rate of progress that will ensure completion of the Work within the stipulated Contract Time.

The Work includes the installation of a new drainage system to mitigate the flooding of North Bayshore Drive. Elements of construction include new positive drainage piping, manholes, inlets, and drainage wells. Roadway reconstruction will be needed including raising of the existing road to higher elevations, new pavement, curb and gutter, and sidewalk, landscaping and new tree planting. Harmonization of construction with some adjacent property owners will also be needed.

Findings


CIP has completed its review of the low bidder, Giannetti Contracting Corp., Inc. and has determined that the company is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and meet all the minimum requirements as stated in the contact documents: a minimum of five (5) years experience under its current business name, in the construction of similar projects including five (5) separate project references of similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references within the past five (5) years and self-perform at least thirty-five percent (35%) of the physical construction work.

Recommendation

Based on the information above, we are recommending the award be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Giannetti Contracting Corp.

Contract Execution

This Project is included on the Economic Stimulus Program List, that was approved at the December 11, 2008 Commission Meeting and therefore, does not require Commission approval for award.
