(Miami, Fla.) – **Miami 21 is scheduled to go before the City Commission for the Second Reading on Thursday, October 22, 2009, at 2:00 p.m.**, at Miami City Hall. Members of the community who are interested in participating are encouraged to attend.

Miami 21 is a blueprint for the City of Miami of the 21st century and beyond. It takes a holistic approach to land use and urban planning, broadening the scope of a traditional master plan to become a truly comprehensive plan. The Miami 21 Zoning Code aims to provide new City regulations that are streamlined, progressive, and relevant to the needs of a changing city. These regulations will encourage the development of safe, vibrant, pedestrian and transit-friendly neighborhoods, so that future generations will reap the benefits of well-balanced neighborhoods and rich quality of life.
