The Chairmen of the City of Miami's Community Redevelopment Agencies ("CRA") are pleased to announce the CRA's 2nd Annual Youth Summer Employment Program. This program provides job training and placement for individuals between the ages of 14 and 24 each summer. This year, the CRA is partnering with Keep Miami Beautiful, Inc. to implement the Environmental Employment Program, which focuses on improving the environment through recycling, litter prevention, and waste minimization efforts. Participants will work up to 30 hours per week for 10 weeks, and earn up to \$9.00 per hour in one of the following industries: Administrative and Support Services, Recreation, Leisure and Hospitality, Professional and Business Services, Repair and Maintenance, and Waste Management.

REQUIREMENTS:

Must be a U.S. Citizen and provide valid government issued identification Social Security Card, and at least one of the following:
Florida Drivers License
Florida I.D. card
Miami Dade County Public School I.D., with Proof of Residence (i.e. utility bill)
Must be between the ages of 14 and 24
(All participants must attend the Green Careers Expo & Community Fair)

There will also be a limited number of positions available in other areas within the City of Miami for participants who currently reside within the Southeast Overtown/Park West and Omni Redevelopment Areas.
2. All participants will be paid through Direct Deposit/Electronic Funds Transfer.
