CITY OF MIAMI PRESENTED WITH \$400,000 CHECK FROM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

-Brownfield Grants to be Used for Blighted Areas in Wynwood & Allapattah-

(Miami, Fla.) – City of Miami Mayor Manny Diaz and District 2 Commissioner Marc Sarnoff will be presented with a \$400,000 check from the Environmental Protection Agency in a press conference on **Wednesday, July 11th, 2007, at 2:00 pm**. The funds are two Brownfield Grants to be used for environmental assessments of the industrial areas in Wynwood and Allapattah.

The press conference will take place at the Continental Florida Materials cement plant in Wynwood, a site that was once contaminated with dry cleaning solvents and with the help of a similar EPA Brownfield grant was converted into a productive center that employs dozens of workers.
