MADD Honors Commissioner Sarnoff

Miami, Florida – April 14, 2008 – This week, the Miami-Dade County chapter of Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) will honor District 2 Commissioner Marc Sarnoff for his commitment to ending D.U.I. crime.

On April 17, 2008, MADD Executive Director Janet Mondshein will present Commissioner Sarnoff with an award of distinction, recognizing the Commissioner's efforts to stop drunk driving and save lives. Among his accomplishments in the fight against D.U.I, Commissioner Sarnoff recently authored a resolution to the Florida State Legislature supporting House Bill 369 "*Driving Under the Influence*" and its companion Senate Bill 456 "*Ignition Interlock Device/DUI*". Earlier this year, the City of Miami passed an ordinance introduced by Commissioner Sarnoff that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Coconut Grove Central Commercial District after 3am.

The awards ceremony, silent auction and dinner will take place at the Rusty Pelican Restaurant - Key Biscayne, 7pm on Thursday.
