---Miami Commissioner Marc Sarnoff Opens City Hall For Free Screening of Documentary that has Hollywood Buzzing---

(Miami, FL)—The eagerly anticipated, critically acclaimed film “The Cove,” is the feature of Miami Commissioner Marc D. Sarnoff’s Film Night Event **on Tuesday, March 31st inside City Hall Chambers at 6:30pm at 3500 Pan American Drive in Coconut Grove. A Q&A with cast and crew, including Miami resident Ric O’Barry, will follow the screening.**
