Construction of the Mooring Field continues and is nearing completion. In addition to buoy placement, we will need to remove hazards to navigation such as derelict and sunken vessels as well as other underwater debris.

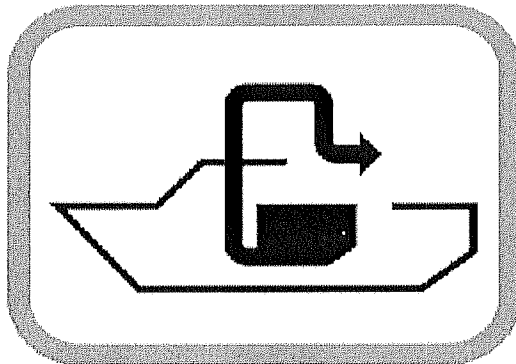
The upland facilities including the Harbormaster's Office are scheduled to be in place in August.
