NOTE: A pre-application meeting is required to be conducted to apply for the permit. Interim Parking Permits require approval from the building department, code compliance, environmental resources, historic preservation (based on location), fire, land development, police, public works, and solid waste. An approved building permit and an issued Temporary Use and Occupancy Permit are required prior to the operation of interim parking.
